

Observation of IAP CPR Week 17th-24th July 2022 for Health Care Providers, Nursing Students and Sulabh Workers

The Medical Education Unit in association with Department of Pediatrics had inaugurated the IAP CPR Centre, CSSC, MEU, AIIMS, Kalyani on 24th July by Hon'ble Executive Director Prof. (Dr.) Ramji Singh, AIIMS Kalyani, Secretary IAP WB and other dignitaries.
