This contract will be valid for **ONE YEAR to be extended up to 1 year** on satisfactory performance and approval of competent authority.

The tender shall be submitted Online in two parts, viz., technical bid and Financial bid. All the pages of bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder irrespective of nature of content of the documents before uploading.

The offers submitted by Fax/email shall not be considered. No correspondence will be entertained in this matter.

- The tenderers may submit tenders for all the items/tests mentioned to cover tender procedure as per Rule. Tenderers are advised to note the qualification criteria specified in the tender document to qualify for award of the contract.

- IV. Tenders of only those Tenderers who fulfill the Terms and conditions of this tender will be considered for evaluation. The tender will undergo evaluation at every stage of processing and any tenderer found at any stage, not in conformity with the stipulated tender conditions including specification / found to be having defective and incomplete documents will be rejected.

The bidders who score at least 60 marks in the technical evaluation, will be called Technically qualified and only their financial bid will be opened.

#### **Financial Bid:**

- 1. The bidders have to quote monthly rental charge over and above Rs 38 per square feet.
- 2. The H1 bidder (i.e. the bidder who quote the highest rental charges) will be selected as the successful bidder and will be awarded the contract.
- **3.** If there is tie in the financial bid then the highest scorer in the technical bid will be selected as the successful bidder and will be awarded the contract.
- 4. In case of tie in both the financial bid and technical bid then the next parameter to

break the tie will be Average Annual Turn Over of the bidder. The bidder with the higher Average Annual Turn Over will be selected as the successful bidder.

#### **General Terms and Conditions: -**

#### 1. Pre-Bid Conference:

All the prospective bidders shall attend the Pre-Bid Conference at Welcome Room of Admin Building of AIIMS, Kalyani on 16/08/2024 11:00 AM. If any changes , may be incorporated in the bidding document after the Pre-Bid Conference and will be uploaded on our official website as "Corrigendum". Therefore, bidders are requested to submit their bids accordingly to revise changes after pre-bid conference, if any. No fresh advertisement will be made for corrigendum.

#### 2. Amendments in Bidding Documents:

At any time till 07 (seven) days before the deadline for submission of bids, the AIIMS Kalyani may, for any reason, whether at own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the bidding document through amendment. All amendments will be uploaded on the website regularly. AIIMS, Kalyani shall not be responsible to notify the amendments to individual bidders. All amendments by the AIIMS, Kalyani till 07 (seven) days before the deadline for submission of bids, shall be bindingon the participatory bidders.

#### 3. Risk Purchase:

In case the tenderer on whom the supply order/ work contract has been placed, fails to make supplies/ carryout the work within the stipulated period, then also the tenderer has to pay the rental charges. If the bidder fails to pay the rental, then it will be recovered from the performance security.

In case of repeated failure in supplying the ordered goods/services work order may be cancelled and Performance security deposit will be forfeited and the firm will be blacklisted for 5(five) years.

#### 4. FALL CLAUSE:

If, at any time, during the said period, the supplier sells the food items in a reduced price to any other person/organization/Institution at a pricelower than the price chargeable, he shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale to the Executive Director, AIIMS, Kalyani, and the price payable for the food items supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale shall stand correspondingly reduced.

#### **5. Performance Security:**

- (a) The successful tenderer will be required to furnish a Performance Security Deposit @ 5 % of total value of contract in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft in favorable of "ALL INDIA INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCE KALYANI" payable at ICICI KALYANI MORE BRANCH within 15 days of awarding the contract. The security deposit can be forfeited or reduced by this Institute in the event of any breach or negligence or non-observance of any condition of contract or for unsatisfactory performance or non-observance of any condition of the contract.
- (b) Performance Security should be kept valid beyond 60 days after completion of obligations under the contract i.e. initially for a period of 14 Months and if the contract is extended, on mutual basis, for another one year then the service provider shall extend it up to another 12 months.
- (c) The Tenderer shall have to execute a Contract Agreement with AIIMS, Kalyani while accepting the Supply/work order.
- **6.** Bidder shall submit the Tender document and addendum thereto, if any, with each page signed withseal to confirm the acceptance of the entire Terms & Conditions as mentioned in the tender enquirydocument.
- **7.** Compliance sheet of the Technical Specification of the goods/services under due signature & Sealwith Technical printed literature must be enclosed with the bid.
- **8.** Conditional Bids will be treated as unresponsive and therefore may be rejected.
- 9. The Institute reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more

Tender / offerwithout assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process and reject all Tenders at any time prior to award of contract, without accepting any liability, whatsoever.

- 10. The Purchaser reserves the right at the time of Contract award to increase or decrease the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions.
- 11. The Procurement of goods and services under this tender will be regulated as per the applicable provision of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), order 2017 of MoC&I (DIPP), Govt. Of India, therefore bidders who are claiming to be regulated under the said order are to submit documentary support in support of their claim.

#### **12.** <u>Debarment from bidding.</u>

- I. A bidder shall be debarred if he has been convicted of an offence
  - a. under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988; or
  - b. the Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of execution of a public procurement contract.
- ii. A bidder debarred under sub-section (i) or any successor of the bidder shall not be eligible to participate in a procurement process of any procuring entity for a period not exceeding three years commencing from the date of debarment. Department of Commerce (DGS&D) will maintain such list which will also be displayed on the website of DGS&D as well as Central Public Procurement Portal.
- iii. A procuring entity may debar a bidder or any of its successors, from participating in any Procurement process undertaken by it, for a period not exceeding two years, if it determines that the bidder has breached the code of integrity. The Ministry/Department will maintain such list which will also be displayed on their website.
- iv. The bidder shall not be debarred unless such bidder has been given a reasonable

opportunity to represent against such debarment.

#### 13. <u>Code of Integrity:</u>

No official of the bidder shall act in contravention of the codes which includes

#### (i) Prohibition of

- (a) Making offer, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to other wise influence the procurement process.
- (b) Any omission, or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefit may be obtained or an obligation avoided.
- (c) Any collusion, bid rigging or anticompetitive behavior that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the procurement process.
- (d) Improper use of information provided by the procuring entity to the bidder with intent to gainunfair advantage in the procurement process or for personal gain.
- (e) Any financial or business transactions between the bidder and any official of the procuring entityrelated to tender or execution process of contract; which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly.
- (f) Any coercion or any threat to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or its property to influence the procurement process.
- (g) Obstruction of any investigation or auditing of a procurement process.
- (h) making false declaration or providing false information for participation in

a tender process or tosecure a contract;

(i) Disclosure of conflict of interest.

Disclosure by the bidder of any previous transgressions made in respect of the provisions of sub-clause with any entity in any country during the last three years or of being debarred by any other procuring entity.

The purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, Fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.

#### 14. Applicable Law:

- The contract shall be governed by the laws and procedures established by Government of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such Commercial dealings / processing.
- Any disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Competent Court and Forum in Kalyani, West Bengal, India, only.
- The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the venue of arbitration shall be at
  - Kalyani. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- **15. Force Majeure**: Any delay due to Force Majeure will be attributable to the supplier unless provided through documentary evidence.
- **16.** Upon the receipt of the notification of Award by the successful Bidder, the successful Bidder shall fill the Agreement in accordance with form of Agreement included in the Bid documents as per Annexure-8 and submit the same to the Employer within two weeks of the date of receipt of notification of Award. The Bidder shall have to execute an agreement with AIIMS, Kalyani in Non- judicial Stamp paper of Rs.100/-.

#### 17. License:

- a. The license agreement shall be valid initially for a period of 01 (One) year from the date of work order and further extendable for another 01 (One) year as stated above, and to could be terminated at any time by giving written notice of 60 days in advance, after providing an opportunity of hearing, in case there occurs violation of terms and conditions of the contract by the licensee. However, during the notice period the required services shall continue to be provided by the bidder.
- b. The licensee shall obtain and arrange a 3<sup>rd</sup> party **Insurance Policies** to cover all the incidents from / to workmen and all Kitchen Equipment involved in the out Sourcing of services, against any mishap. The insurance policy for the workers to be involved for services shall be obtained every year by the service provider till the last date of completion of contract.
- c. The licensee shall be abided by all the guidelines issued by the Government of India and The Executive Director, AIIMS, Kalyani, West Bengal, from time to time during the lease period.
- d. The licensee shall not sell or transfer any proprietary right or entrust any other third party to run the Hospital Patient Dietary services.
- e. The licensee shall observe the guidelines issued by health authorities for the control on spread of contamination.
- f. Conforming to the services under the provision of the 'Consumer Protection Act' shall be the sole and absolute responsibility of the (2<sup>nd</sup> party) licensee and the first party will share no liability in this regard. Privacy and other ethical values of investigated patients will have to be maintained in individual case.
- 18. Wages to employees and Insurance: The service provider shall comply with the laws applicable to employees working in the Kiosks regarding working hours, minimum wages, safety, cleanliness, etc. If on account of non-compliance with the provisions of any such laws, AIIMS Hospital is upon to make any payment to or in respect of his employees, the service provider shall fully reimburse to the employer all such payment or the first party shall be free to make deductions on this account from the amount of Security Deposit, in which case, the service provider shall immediately pay to the employer such amount as maybe necessary to make up the required security Deposit, or from the dues which may be payable to employer to

the bidder. The service provider will sign an Indemnity Bond in favor of the first party to this effect.

#### **SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- 1. The FOOD KIOSK can sell ONLY OWN COMPANY PRODUCTS for which the bidder is applying (along with the list of products as mentioned in annexure-3).
- 2. It should have provision for WIDE RANGE of Food products made by their own company.
- 3. It should have own arrangement for internal distribution of their company products within AIIMS Kalyani Campus.
- 4. NO PLASTIC PACKETS ALLOWED IN THE FOOD KIOSK; consumables (Cups, spoon, serving trays) should be environment friendly.
- 5. It Should involve only Fireless Cooking.
- 6. Hot and Cold beverages to be served through own Coffee Vending Machines
- 7. The contractor should bear rental(monthly) charges (As per Financial bid), electricity bills (based on meter reading).
- 8. The contractor should have business exposure with wide range of own Company food products across India.
- 9. The **5 allotted slots** of around **200 Sq. ft.(approx.)** should be utilised by the agency to **build 5 food kiosks** with furniture, at their own expenses.
- 10. The contractor (licensee of a particular company) cannot exhibit any advertisement **except displaying his own name & Brand Name**. If the Licensee exhibits any advertisement other than his own / franchisee name, his contract will be terminated.
- 11. The company should have business exposure with wide range of own Company food products across India.
- 12. The contractor is expected to as endorsed by GOI (CIRCULAR No. T20014/28/2023-SAS-1 issued by Director General of Health Services).
  - a. keep millet products, Fresh fruit juices, nuts, whole grains.
  - b. Preferably avoid keeping and selling unhealthy beverages with high sugar content.
  - c. Preferably avoid keeping and selling packaged processed food with high content of salt, sugar and preservatives
- 13. Apart from the company products, low cost standard quality coffee, Tea, Biscuit must be available in the kiosks as per Annexure-3.
- 14. Company can't establish different flavours of kiosk; all the 5 kiosks have to be of same parent company for which the bidder applies.
- 15. Full menu along with the cost must be displayed at counter.
- 16. The contractor shall maintain FULL HYGIENIC CONDITIONS in the kiosks, in the storage, preparation and serving of eatables and in keeping the floor, furniture, utensils, crockery, cutlery neat and clean, so as to maintain the standards and aesthetic values

in the kiosks. Contractor should make arrangement for visible storage of prepared food in hygienic condition. The kiosks and its premises shall be kept clean and tidy. The garbage, peel-offs, waste food etc. should be disposed of as per norms of appropriate Municipal Authority at the cost of the Contractor. Smoking, tobacco chewing and intake of liquor is strictly prohibited. The bidder should not allow and should take active participation and responsibility in driving out the dogs surrounding the designated place.

- 17. Biomedical Waste standards must be maintained including hygiene and fly catcher must be installed.
- 18. Separate counter for AIIMS KALYANI staff must be there.
- 19. The contractor must adhere to the timings.
  - a. 3 counters (Entrance Gate, OPD Ground Floor and OPD 3rd Floor)

Mon-Fri: Full Day Sat: Half day (1st half)

#### b. 2 counters (In Front of Trauma & Emergency and Hostel)

- Must be open for all time. (24\*7)
- 20. Adequate number of staffs should be present per shift.
- 21. Staff behaviour **must be polite**.
- 22. All staff and the Caterer will have to be provided uniforms with ID cards by the Contractor (which will be countersigned by the AIIMS administration) during working hours and they are required to wear disposable gloves and caps during cooking and serving food positively.
- 23. Extension of area or creation of additional plaza outside the permitted/allotted area will not be permitted.
- 24. The contractor will be liable to the damages caused to the property of the AIIMS Kalyani, if any, during the execution/creation of the FOOD KIOSK. The full liability and responsibility will also lie over the successful bidder due to any damage to the property, animal or human due to any unforeseen incident/accident caused by the said restaurant.
- 25. The contractor shall handover the peaceful possession of the FOOD KIOSK (land & structure and other fittings owned by AIIMS Kalyani) and remove all particles/assets of their own within seven days from the date of expiry/ termination of the contract, failing which, the AIIMS Kalyani Authority will take the possession of the FOOD KIOSK with immediate effect. Necessary expenses for this purpose incurred by the AIIMS Kalyani authority will be paid by the party on demand, failing which it will be deducted from the security Deposit money.
- 26. No permanent construction will be allowed in the campus of AIIMS Kalyani.
- 27. If any bidder has more than one franchises, he/she should apply for only one.

#### **ASSIGNMENT & SUBLETTING:**

- 1. The contractors shall not assign the contract or any part thereof or any benefit or interest therein or there under without written consent of the Institute. The whole of the charge included in the contract shall be executed by the Contractors.
- 2. The Contractors should not transfer the management to any other individual or agency.
- 3. The Executive Director, AIIMS, Kalyani will have discretion to add or amend any conditions of this contract at any time and the contractors will be bound to comply with the same. The same may be hoisted in the AIIMS KALYANI website.

#### **CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:**

- 1. The contracts documents are to be taken mutually explanatory of one another and in case of ambiguities or discrepancies the same shall be explained and clarified by the Institute who shall thereupon issue to the contractor their interpretation and direction in what manner the work is to be carried out.
- 2. No child laborer will be employed by the Contractors in the Refreshment service and the Institute shall be at liberty to object to and require the Contractors to remove any person employed by the contractor in running the refreshment services, who in the opinion of the Institute is unbecoming of being employed in the canteen. Such persons shall not again be employed in the canteen without the specific permission of the Concerned Committee.
- **3.** The Contractors shall be responsible for the acts, defaults and neglects of its employees, or workmen.
- **4.** All the workers engaged by the contractors will be solely his employees and the contractors will ensure compliance of all labour laws as applicable including payment of minimum wages (calculated on basis of tier I city). They will also comply all other laws of the land as applicable. AIIMS, Kalyani will have no liabilities in this connection.

#### **COMPLIANCE OF STATUTORY LIABILITIES:**

- 1. The electricity charge & Monthly rental charge has to be deposited positively without fail within 5 working days of the next month. Otherwise, penalty shall be imposed as decided by AIIMS, Kalyani.
- 2. The contractors shall ensure that wages paid to his employees conform to the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 and other social security like EPF, ESIC and Bonus etc. The Contractors shall also ensure adequate rest and working hours as per norms etc. to all his employees.

**3.** The contractor shall be totally responsible for all statutory liabilities including those relating to Weights and Measures and Prevention of Food Adulteration

#### **SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE:**

All disputes related to refreshment services, service charge, electric bill, management, maintaining hygiene and abiding rules and regulation framed by concerned committee shall be settled amicably between administrative authorities of AIIMS, Kalyani and the Contractors. If amicable settlement fails and as required, an Arbitrator shall be appointed on mutual consent within the Institute by administrative authorities of AIIMS, Kalyani. Any legal dispute if so, arise shall be subject to jurisdiction of courts in Kalyani only. (Administration of AIIMS KALYANI). An arbitration may be initiated as per "Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996".

#### **PENALTY CLAUSE:**

# In case of violation of the following rules, the penalty charges on the Caterer shall be followed.

- a. For single complaint of presence of maggots, insects and/or foreign object found in any food items would invite a fine of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only) on the caterer.
- b. Fine on any discrepancy (personal hygiene of workers, misbehavior by workers, Garbage disposal in case of buffet) will lead to fine of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only) on caterer for every instance.
- c. For single complaint of non-availability of the products mentioned in Annexure-3 would invite a fine of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per instance on the caterer.
- d. If there is any damage of assets of AIIMS Kalyani, the quantum of fine will be decided by competent authority.
- e. Absence of the proprietor or his representative in the meetings organized by the Concerned Authority on prior information will attract a fine of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) on caterer.
- f. In case it is found that **three such fines** do not have any effect in abiding by the terms and conditions mentioned in the contract, the contract may be terminated finally after serving fifteen days' notice by the Administration of AIIMS KALYANI to the Contractors. The notice during the trial period will be only one week.
- g. Severity of hygiene failure shall be assessed and decided by the Concerned Committee and fined appropriately. In case of gross failure/negligence a severe penalty will be imposed.
